MORE THAN a month after a Vadodara-based family accused the gynaecology department of SSG hospital of a child swap, demanding a DNA test on their new baby, the report of the DNA test has concluded on that the baby is the biological child of the couple.

The baby and the mother have been put up at SSG hospital since the incident occurred on October 30, when a staff nurse brought a newborn girl to the father, who refused to accept the baby and claimed he had first been told that his wife had delivered a baby boy. On Saturday, over a month af-

ter an inquiry was set up into the allegations of "child swapping" at the hospital and the family had also complained to the Raopura police station, SSG hospital received the report of the DNA test conducted on the newborn as well as her parents. The report of the test, conducted on November 8, concluded that the baby indeed

belonged to the couple. Medical Superintendent Dr Ranjan Aiyersaid, "On October 30, a woman had delivered a baby girl... But the family had a misunderstanding that the woman had delivered a baby boy. There was a ruckus in the hospital and a police complaint had also been filed. ... For the satisfaction of the family, we conducted the DNA tests and the FSL report has proven that the

baby belongs to the couple."

The family has now accepted the baby girl, the hospital said.
