Kerala PF leader hacked to death in front of father

Car used by killers registered in name of slain RSS leader S Sanjith, says SP

A POPULAR Front of India (PFI) leader was hacked to death in the local mosque in Ellapally, where he and his father, Aboobacker, had gone to offer the congregational Friday prayers, police said.

The PFI state president C P Muhammed Basheer has blamed the RSS, saying "the conspiracy behind the (Subair's) murder is clear". "By killing a local PFI leader, RSS wants to foment communal trouble. During the Ram Navami celebration, RSS had unleashed attacks on Muslims. In Palakkad also they had issued provocative statements. RSS has targeted a person who came out of the mosque. Strong protest should be raised from all quarters against RSS terrorism," Basheer said.

Denying his party's role in the RSS involvement, BJP Palakkad district president K M Haridas said: "The murder is part of PFI-SDPI conspiracy to shatter the peace in the district. BJP workers have no role in it. We would not allow PFI-SDPI to loot the murder on Singh Turan organisations."

Meanwhile, police have sounded an alert across the state to prevent further retaliatory attacks or violence. SP Vishwanadhi said special control rooms will be set up and night patrol intensified too.

In December last, BJP leader Ranjith Sreenivasan was killed in Alappuzha, barely 12 hours after the killing of SDPI leader K S Shan in the same district.

Bag with evidence in case against minister stolen from court: AP police

A BAG containing a laptop, iPad and three cellphones — all belonging to newly inducted State Agriculture Minister Kakani Govardhan Reddy and part of "evidence" against him in a forgery and defamation case — was stolen from the fourth additional judicial magistrate's court in Nellore, police said.

An officer at the local police station where the complaint of theft was filed by court clerk on April 13 said two of the six persons who broke into the court safe had been detained. They discarded the empty bag near the court. The two detained persons are being questioned. We hope to catch the main culprits soon," he said.

The defamation case against Govardhan Reddy, who was inducted as minister by Chief Minister Y Jagan Mohan Reddy in the reshuffle on April 10, was filed by then TDP minister Somreddy Chandramohan Reddy in December 2016.

Hindi will promote unity, help realise dream of Akhand Bharat: Goa CM

GOA CHIEF Minister Pramod Sawant on Friday said that promoting the Hindi language will not only keep India's oneness intact but also help us realise the dream of 'Akhand Bharat'.

Speaking at the 8th International Hindi Conference held in Panaji Friday, Sawant said: "We talk of unity in diversity and the dream of Akhand Bharat that we have raised. We have moved ahead with this dream and this dream has been made into reality by PM Narendra Modi. It is important to promote Hindi to unite and diversify."

The Chief Minister, who was recently sworn in for his second term in the office, is also the minister for Official Language in the state. He said that along with Hindi, all regional languages would be promoted in Goa. Inter-faith clemence: Mob sets two houses on fire in Agra

EIGHT PERSONS were arrested on Friday for allegedly setting two houses of a Muslim man on fire in Agra.

According to the police, the arson was carried out by members of Dham Jagran Samanay Sangh, a local right-wing outfit, to demand the arrest of one Sajid, who allegedly eloped with a Hindu woman. The police said the woman had gone with the man out of her own will and her statement was yet to be recorded. Abooth-charged has been suspended, while the role of the Sikandra police station SHO is being probed in connection with the case.

At the time of the incident, no family member was inside the house. "We received information that some persons set ablaze the house of a woman in Panakia area. They alleged that he had kidnapped a girl and demanded his arrest. Four days ago, the man and the woman, of two different religions, had gone together. We have used the woman and further investigation is on," said Agra SP Sushil Kumar Singh.

According to police, the woman lives in the vicinity and was known to Sajid (22). The family members and locals in the area alleged that Sajid had kidnapped the minor four days ago. The police said the woman was in fact an adult and had gone with him willingly.

Sarpanch shot dead in F&K village, 4th attack since March

SUSPECTED MILITANTS shot dead a sarpanch in Pattan area of north Kashmir's Ramanulla district on Friday, police said, the fourth such attack on grassroots representatives in the Valley this year.

Political parties have condemned the killing, which comes less than two weeks ahead of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Jammu, where he is expected to address members of the Panchayati Raj Institutions.

Police said Manzoor Ahmad Bangroo, who was the sarpanch of Goshgubi village, was not associated with any political party.

In this terror crime, he received critical gunshot injuries and was immediately evacuated to nearby hospital for treatment. However, doctors declared him dead on arrival," a police statement said, adding the area has

been cordoned off and a search is on for the attackers.

While condemning the incident, the Peoples Democratic Party asked why killings of sarpanchs in the Valley have continued "despite multiple security assessments and bundling them in secure accommodations in Srinagar". "There seems to be no end in sight to the bloodbath in Kashmir. Yet nothing seems to move GOI towards to change its approach towards J&K," PDP chief Mehbooba Mufti tweeted.

Two sarpanchs were killed in south Kashmir's Kulgam district and one on the outskirts of Srinagar in March.

On March 12, Shabir Ahmad Mir, the sarpanch of Kulgam's Auzia village, was shot dead by suspected militants. Police said he had been staying at a hotel in Srinagar "for security reasons" and had left for his village without informing them. On March 9, Sameer Ahmad Bhat, who

Tribal girl 'gangraped', male friend assaulted in Birbhum, say police

A 15-YEAR-OLD tribal girl was allegedly gangraped and her male friend assaulted in Birbhum district on Thursday, the police said, adding that the minor, in her statement, said four to five people were involved in the incident.

As per preliminary probe, the girl was visiting a fair with her friend on Thursday and was engaged in a conversation with him when about four to five people assaulted him before dragging her away to a secluded place by a river, where she was allegedly gangraped. She somehow managed to make her way home and was later admitted to a hospital, the police said, adding that an FIR has been filed in connection with the incident.

On learning about the alleged incident, Birbhum SP Nagendra Tripathi and other senior police officers visited the village. The SP also met the girl at the hospital. "As per the primary information, the girl has complained of being gangraped. She said fine and is able to speak. A medical examination has been conducted on her and the reports are awaited. We will use tower dumping to track down the accused persons," the SP said.

Tower dumping technology helps investigators obtain information on cell phone active in the area around a particular mobile tower. Tripathi said police artists were trying to make sketches of the accused based on the description given by the victim's friend. The accused are suspected to be outsiders visiting the fair, a senior police officer said.
