THE PETITIONER RESPECTFULLY SUBMITS AS UNDER:

“Jubilant Infrastructure Limited (JIL)”, hereinafter referred to as the “Petitioner”, files the petition for the Approval of Power Procurement from Co-generation based Thermal Power Source.

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1. BACKGROUND

Jubilant Infrastructure Limited, hereinafter referred to as "Petitioner or JIL", is a company incorporated in 2008 under the Companies Act, 1956, and is a wholly owned subsidiary of Jubilant Ingrevia Limited.

Ministry of Commerce and Industry, GoI vide notification No. 290 (E) dated 11th Feb, 2008 has notified JIL as SEZ Developer to set up sector-specific Special Economic Zone (SEZ) for Chemicals in proposed area of 107 hectares at Vilayat, District Bharuch, Gujarat.

Vide notification dated 3rd Mar, 2010 under Section 49(1) (b) of the SEZ Act, 2005 Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Department of Commerce), GoI has specified that the developer of a SEZ is deemed to be a Distribution Licensee under the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 (hereinafter referred to as "EA, 2003"). EA, 2003 was amended through Notification dated 3rd March, 2010 to add a proviso to Section 14 (b), which is reproduced below:

"14. Grant of License

The Appropriate Commission may, on an application made to it under section 15, grant a license to any person –

- a. To transmit electricity as a transmission licensee: or*
- b. To distribute electricity as a Distribution Licensee; or:*

Provided that the Developer of a Special Economic Zone notified under sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the Special Economic Zones Act, 2005, shall be deemed to be a licensee for the purpose of this clause, with effect from the date of notification of such Special Economic Zone;"

The Hon'ble Commission vide Letter No. 02152/GERC/Legal/2012 dated 11th Oct, 2012 has granted the distribution license to the Petitioner bearing License No. 07 of 2012 in the SEZ area notified by Ministry of Commerce & Industry, GoI and also approved the Map of the distribution of electricity license area. The said license still continues and held by the Petitioner.

Approval of Power from Co-generation-based Thermal Power Source

Department of Commerce and Industries (SEZ Section) also notified adjoining plot no. 4 admeasuring 18.55.92 hectares in the original SEZ area (107.16.50) on 05th Sep, 2017 (enclosed at Annexure - 1) making the Total SEZ area of 125.72.42 Hectares and a Rectification Lease Deed in favor of JIL is already executed by GIDC on dated 22nd June, 2016.

The Petitioner being the Developer of the SEZ is also responsible for development, operations and maintenance of all utility services including distribution of electricity within the SEZ area to provide consumers with plug-n-play services. Accordingly, the Petitioner developed a 66kV switchyard /substation to source power from GRID and connected through double circuit line including 11 kV network to supply power to consumers in the SEZ area and also to manage the utility services.

The Petitioner has taken the Distribution License from Hon'ble commission but due to certain reasons like low load demand, variability in load and being new to the distribution business, we have not taken forward to move as Licensee at that point of time in year 2012-13. Considering the sufficient loads and readiness of the distribution Network at SEZ area, Petitioner intends to start its operation as a Licensee.

On request of JIL, Hon'ble Commission on 03rd August, 2023 allowed JIL to initiate operations as a distribution licensee and to source power directly from other distribution companies, generating sources, power exchanges and other options available in Indian power market and get the benefit of competitive power market pricing, under various time horizons as per load requirements.



2. EXISTING POWER PROCUREMENT ARRANGEMENTS

JIL is structured to provide quality infrastructure to attract investment as well as generate employment and revenue for the state. In order to ensure a reliable and secure power supply to its consumers, JIL has established grid connectivity with GETCO at the 66 kV voltage level and has developed the necessary distribution infrastructure within its licensed area. At present, JIL is supplying electricity to five consumers at the 11 kV voltage level, and miscellaneous connections at 0.415 kV level.

The connected load within its licensed area is projected to increase to 18.176 MVA by FY 2029–30 with two additional connections – ICICI ATM at 3 kVA and Gujarat Gas at 10 kVA.

3. PROPOSED POWER PROCUREMENT FROM A NEW SOURCE

As per the Clause 4(vi) of the Guidelines issued by the Department of Commerce (SEZ Division), Government of India, dated 27th October 2010, stipulates that Special Economic Zones (SEZs) shall be self-reliant in power supply and capable of providing 24x7 uninterrupted and quality power. The said Guidelines also encourage SEZ Developers to undertake power distribution either directly or through a co-developer, and to source power from generating stations located in other SEZs or through the establishment of captive power plants:

“(vi) Power Supply: It would be appropriate that the SEZ is self-dependent on power supply and the SEZs should be able to provide 7 x 24 hours uninterrupted quality power supply. It would be desirable for Developer to undertake distribution of power either on its own or through a Co-Developer and source power from power plants located in other SEZs or set up a captive power plant.”

The current petition is filed before the Hon'ble Commission in line with clause 108.1.2 of the GERC MYT Regulations 2024:

“108.1.2 All future procurement of short-term or medium-term or long-term power, including Renewable Energy, shall invariably be undertaken through competitive bidding in accordance with Guidelines notified by the Government of India under Section 63 of the Act:

Provided that in case either no competitive bids are received or the bids received are higher than the prevailing market rates or on any other sufficient reason, then the Distribution Licensee may procure medium-term or long-term power under Section 62 of the Act, subject to fulfilling the conditions specified in Regulation 108.1.3 to 108.1.9 of these Regulations.

Provided further that in case of any proposal for procurement of power through MoU route, the Distribution Licensee shall obtain prior approval of the Commission.”

In line with the above provisions, JIL is filing the current petition seeking approval for the long-term power procurement plan from M/s Jubilant Infrastructure Limited's Co-generation based Thermal Power Source (Industrial Co-generation Plant).

M/s Jubilant Infrastructure Limited (herein also referred as 'consumer'), an existing consumer under JIL's Power Distribution Business (Consumer Number: 4), has commissioned a 98 TPH coal-based CFBC boiler to meet its process steam requirements. Further, the company has integrated a steam turbine generator (STG) with the boiler system to optimize energy utilization through cogeneration. This configuration facilitates the simultaneous generation of electrical energy and process steam, thereby enhancing overall energy efficiency. Based on the available steam turbine capacity, up to 10 MW of electricity can be generated. The turbine extracts the requisite process steam, ensuring efficient cogeneration operation and improved cycle efficiency.

The boiler and steam turbine generator has commenced commercial operations from 14th December 2025 and are generating approximately ~3.5 MW of electricity at present, commensurate with the process steam requirements of the chemical production facility. The electricity generation is

based on a **CFBC boiler system**, which has been primarily installed to meet the process steam requirements of the plant.)

Consequently, the power generated through this cogeneration process is available at a highly competitive cost of **₹3.50 per kWh**. The consumer has formally proposed to sell the entire quantum of electricity generated from the cogeneration facility to JIL's Power Distribution Business at the aforesaid rate, at the bus bar of the Licensee's sub-station of 66/11 kV (JIL – Power Distribution Division). Further, as the project is located within the JIL SEZ area, no transmission charges shall be applicable on the power procured from this source.)

Further, during FY 2024–25 and FY 2025–26, the average market clearing price at the Power Exchange was approximately ₹4.47 per unit and ₹3.84 per unit, respectively, reflecting the volatility prevailing in short-term market prices. In comparison, the tariff discovered through the DEEP (Discovery of Efficient Electricity Price) portal for comparable bilateral or medium-term transactions during the same period was observed to be as high as ₹6.99 per unit for Short Term and ₹5.99 for Medium Term.

After due diligence and comprehensive evaluation, the proposal has been assessed to be prudent, technically sound, and economically viable, with the offered tariff being highly competitive under prevailing market conditions. Further, the plant is compliant with applicable environmental, safety, and grid connectivity norms.

In view of the above, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between JIL and the generator (attached herewith in **Annexure-A**) and the energy supply has commenced on 15th December 2025 to JIL. Further, if the Commission suggests any changes in the MoU, JIL, in consultation with the generator, shall accordingly modify, add, or delete the relevant clauses.

For the procurement of expected quantum of power generation at a tariff of ₹3.50 per kWh for a period of one year and later an **annual escalation of 2%** on the base tariff calculated up to two decimal places, following table is summarised:

The Petitioner also submits that its contingent power requirements shall be met through Power Exchanges. Further, in the event of any shortfall, the Petitioner may procure power through Power Exchanges or through bilateral arrangements with other agencies, in accordance with the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003.

Upon successful completion of the contractual period of initial 12 years, the consumer and the Licensee may, by mutual consent, review, negotiate, and revise the quantum and tariff, as may be deemed appropriate, subject to prior approval of the Hon'ble Commission.

4. PRAYERS TO THE HON'BLE COMMISSION

The present Petition is submitted before the Hon'ble Commission under Section 62 read with Section 86(1)(b) of the Electricity Act 2003 seeking the following prayers:

- a) Accept and admit the present petition.
- b) Approve the long-term power procurement plan from M/s Jubilant Infrastructure Limited's Co-generation based Thermal Power Source (Industrial Co-generation Plant) for a period of twelve (12) years, and further extendable subject to mutual agreement.
- c) Determine if required, and approve the tariff of ₹3.50 per kWh with annual escalation of 2% for procurement of power from the said co-generation source under Section 62 of the Electricity Act, 2003, for the proposed period and extended, and to pass such other order(s) as the Hon'ble Commission may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case.
- d) Allow JIL to procure power through power exchange or any other means as permissible under the GERC Regulations in case of any contingent load requirement vis-à-vis allow the petitioner to sale of surplus power via bilateral mode or through Power Exchange in case any situation arises where power requirement is less than the contracted power;
- e) Condone any shortcomings/deficiencies and allow JIL to submit additional information/data at a later state as may be required.

4. Operational, technical, and regulatory considerations.

4. Background and Context

The meeting was convened to explore the possibility of sourcing thermal power from the Cogen thermal power plant owned by the Jubilant Infrastructure, which has surplus generation capacity. The Distribution Licensee expressed interest in procuring reliable and cost-effective power to meet its demand and reduce dependence on higher-cost sources.

5. Discussion Points**5.1 Availability of Power**

- The Jubilant Infrastructure informed that the Cogen Thermal Power Plant has an **installed capacity of 10 MW**.
- Out of the installed capacity, after adjusting auxiliary consumption, following capacity and energy is expected to be available as surplus power available for JIL:

FY 25-26	FY 26-27	FY 27-28	FY 28-29 and onwards
3 MW	4 MW	6.5 MW	7.5 MW
6.48 Mus	34.56 Mus	56.16 Mus	64.8 Mus

- The consumer confirmed that the plant is compliant with applicable environmental, safety, and grid connectivity norms.
- Delivery Point: 11 KV S/Stn situated in the area of JIL.

5.2 Offered Tariff and Commercial Terms

- The consumer offered to supply thermal power to the Distribution Licensee at a **base tariff of Rs. 3.50 per unit (kWh)**.
- An **annual tariff escalation of 2%** on the base tariff has been proposed to be applied on a year-on-year basis. - The revised rate shall be effective from 1st April of each financial year. Accordingly, first revision shall be effective from 1st April, 2026. The tariff rate shall be calculated and considered up to two decimal places.
- The tariff is proposed to be exclusive of applicable taxes, duties, and statutory levies, which shall be payable as per prevailing regulations.
- The consumer clarified that the offered tariff is competitive and reflects fuel cost, operation & maintenance expenses, and reasonable return.

5.3 Contract Tenure

- The indicative contract period discussed was **12 years**, and extendable for further 1 term i.e. 12 Years subject to mutual agreement and prior approval of GERC. The start of power supply shall be date on which electricity is first delivered to distribution licensee.
- The Distribution Licensee suggested that the tenure and exit clauses be aligned with regulatory approvals and power procurement guidelines.

5.4 Scheduling, Delivery, and Reliability

- Power supply would be scheduled as per mutually agreed schedules and in accordance with State Load Dispatch Centre (SLDC) / Regional Load Dispatch Centre (RLDC) procedures.
- The consumer agreed to maintain reasonable availability and inform the Distribution Licensee in advance about planned outages.
- Deviation settlement mechanism (DSM) and grid discipline provisions would be applicable as per prevailing regulations.

5.5 Regulatory and Approval Aspects

- The Distribution Licensee highlighted that procurement of power would be subject to approval from the appropriate Electricity Regulatory Commission.
- The consumer agreed to provide all necessary technical, financial, and compliance-related information required for regulatory filings.
- Both parties acknowledged that the final agreement would be aligned with the Electricity Act, applicable regulations, and government policies.

5.6 Risk Sharing and Force Majeure

- Broad principles related to force majeure events such as fuel supply disruptions, grid failures, and natural calamities were discussed.
- Detailed risk allocation and mitigation measures would be finalized during Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) negotiations.

6. Key Understandings

- The Distribution Licensee acknowledged the consumer's offer of thermal power at **INR. 3.50/unit with 2% annual escalation.**

- Both parties agreed that the proposal is subject to detailed due diligence, commercial negotiations, and regulatory approval.

7. Next Meeting

- It was agreed to convene the next meeting after review of the detailed proposal and internal approvals.

8. Closure

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to all participants. Both parties expressed willingness to engage further to explore a mutually beneficial arrangement for thermal power procurement.
